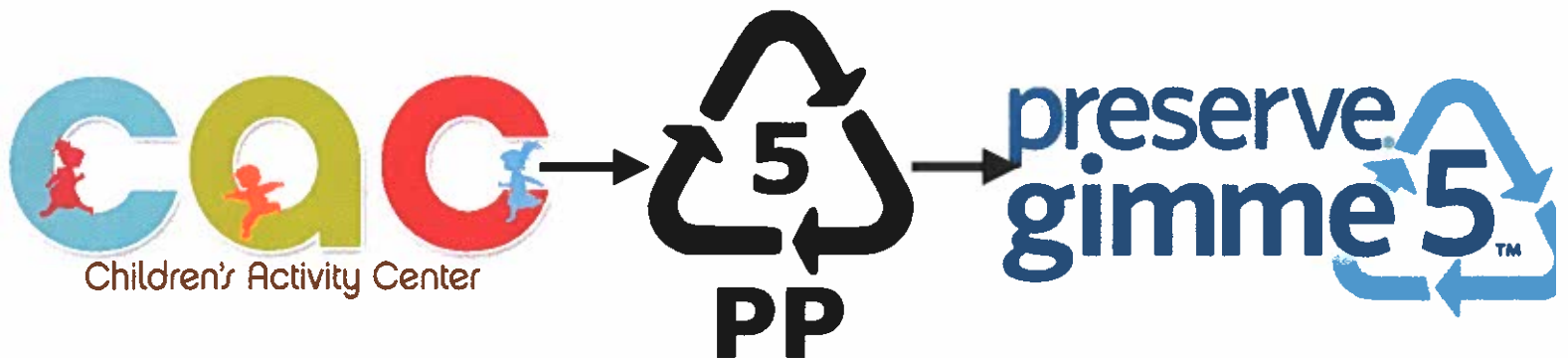


The Children's Activity Center is now collecting... through the Preserve program



Preserve created the “Gimme 5” program to help consumers “close the loop” in their product lifespan. The items that are collected are able to be turned into new Preserve products, all done within the U.S. By collecting clean, stamped #5 products, one exception being plastic caps, Preserve is able to make toothbrushes, shaving products, bowls, plates, silverware, etc.

Why #5? Polypropylene is one of the safest plastics, but one of the least recycled plastics.

Come drop off your #5 products in our collection bin. Please make sure all containers are clean and medicine bottles have their labels taken off. The CAC will do the rest.
